I entered the United States Navy in May 1945. Boot Camp training was in San Diego, California. After training in San Diego, I was stationed at Shoemaker, California, San Bruno, California and then I was attached to the USS Cache in San Francisco, California.

After the assignment on the Cache, I returned to the Navy Training center at San Diego, California. I reported to the USS LSM 15, and we sailed this ship from San Diego through the Panama Canal to Charleston, South Carolina to be decommissioned. From there, I reported to the Navy Repair Base in New Orleans, La. I was discharged in New Orleans in 1946. I remained in the Naval Reserve and was notified in 1952 to be prepared to be recalled during the Korean War. Since I was a discharged veteran, they reclassified me, and I was not recalled into the Navy.
