THE DIAPER BAG

Send all necessary supplies in your bag including: diapers, wipes, bottles, sippy cups and an extra change of clothes (for children under the age of 3).

Snack: Please read our allergy policy under HEALTH.

PROMOTION

Babies through Toddlers promote to older classes within the preschool year as they mature and develop in their abilities.

Parents will be notified by mail when Preschoolers promote to a new placement.

2-year-olds (as of September 1) and older promote annually.

LABELING

Label **EVERYTHING** with your child's name: diaper bags, pacifiers, bottles, etc. Labels help us ensure your child's items are returned and kept for their use only.

Babies: Only pack plastic bottles* with pre-measured formula and water. (*Due to the number of children in our care, we are only able to bottle feed.)

Preschool: Beginning in Toddler classes through age 4, children receive a snack of either apple juice* or water. (*Unless another beverage is listed on the Allergy Alert sign.)

Nursing Room: A nursing room is available in the Preschool Building for feeding and changing.

SPECIAL NEEDS

If your child has special needs, we encourage you to contact the Children's Ministry Office prior to bringing your child to Sunday school. Mainstreaming is available when deemed appropriate or a Special Needs program can also meet individual needs. Our Children's Ministry Team will work together with you to determine the best placement for your child.

SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY

A computerized Check-in System is provided for Preschoolers (Birth—Pre-kindergarten). Parents will receive three labels: one for the child, one for the teacher and one for parents to use when picking up their child. Labels are cross-checked before the child is released. Misplaced labels are available at the Children's Welcome Desk upon providing a picture I.D.

Text pagers are available to all parents if needed.

Our Security System will ring your cell phone or text the pager provided if you are needed. (Please turn your cell phone to "vibrate" mode and keep it nearby.)

Parents must remain at the door when dropping off and picking up children in the classrooms.

BIG CHURCH

All Preschoolers entering 5-year-old Kindergarten classes (our Elementary Ministry) begin attending "Big Church" with their parents.

An annual Big Church Seminar for Preschoolers and their parents is an excellent way to prepare families to attend worship together. Children will receive their first "Big Church Bible"!

ILLNESS POLICIES

For the safety and health of all children, pediatricians recommend that children be kept at home until free of the following symptoms for at least 24 hours:

- Fever
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Persistent cough
- Runny nose

CHECK-IN SECURITY

We strive to maintain a nut-free environment (and/or foods processed near nuts).

All snacks are provided. Snacks from outside environments are not permitted. (Children who cannot consume a classroom snack because of allergies may make arrangements ahead of time to provide their own.)

Snacks are posted monthly on the church website www.gabc.org and weekly for each session outside the classroom door. Detailed snack information (labels, etc.) provided upon request.

Please make your child's teacher and the Children's Ministry Team aware of your child's allergies. Allergy notes may be filed in our database and/or printed on your child's label.

VOLUNTEER

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- A national, security check and approval by our Children's Team.
- Volunteers ages 14 -16 must serve in classrooms of children who are at least two years old. Children under 14 are not permitted in Preschool classrooms.
- Two adults will always be placed in each classroom.

PALS

PALS volunteer with preschoolers during their second hour of Sunday School. Preschoolers from birth through 4 years old, enjoy a less structured hour of story time, music, play time and Bible related activities. We ask all of our parents to serve a minimum of once per quarter (with some choosing monthly). All curriculum, materials, schedules and activities are provided.
