## *Lead In Activity Sheet*

### Group 1

#### INDIGENOUS PEOPLE

Your group has lived in your country all of their lives, complete with culture and language that is particular to your area. In fact, no one else in the world speaks your language. The other group is full of newcomers to your area. They have a problem, but they don't have a translator to communicate to you clearly. Try to figure out what they need. You can ask questions, but, remember, you don't speak their language, and they don't speak yours. You may draw, but everyone in your people group is left-handed. You may also try to act out any questions or comments.

### Group 2

#### NEWCOMERS

Your group is part of a puppet entertainment crew. You all have come to a new country to put on your production for the children. Unfortunately, the airline lost your puppet gear. You are now in a foreign country, whose language you do not speak (and they do not speak yours), and without a translator (He overslept and had to take a later flight.). You need to communicate to them that you need to buy some puppets and some PVC pipe to make a stage for a children's show. You may use paper and pencil or your acting abilities to try to communicate, but, remember, you don't understand any of their words, and they don't understand yours.
